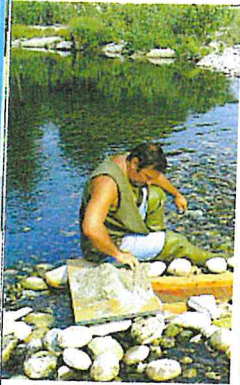

THE QUALITY OF WATERS

This river is still blue

The Ticino is clean, with some areas even permitting swimming. This thanks to its geomorphological features and to the control and monitoring operations carried out by the Park

The Ticino water is a precious source of good for all the ecosystems that gravitate around the river. In spite of all the assaults on its purity, it still has the same colour which has led the Ticino to be known as the "blue river" since time immemorial. Its springs are in Switzerland, at the Novena pass, and after a section in Switzerland, the river flows into Lake Maggiore, from which it flows out near Sesto Calende. After crossing the high and the low Po Plain for 100 km, it flows in the Po river at the Becca Bridge in Linarolo, Pavia. It follows just one course until Vizzola Ticino where it then opens out into various branches, in an increasingly larger valley. Along many stretches, especially in the north, bathing is possible, a record that no other large Italian river can boast. Many experts believe that it is the luck of the Ticino's fortunes to flow fast towards the valley and that its bed is made of sand and siliceous gravel, which makes self-depuration possible. According to others, the river was in a desperate state in the late 1960s, but regained new life thanks to the action of the Park which, though not given specific instruction in this direction, since 1999 has been carefully monitoring all the variables that affect the state of the waters, strongly encouraging relevant institutions and consortia which have the authority. Samples are collected from a series of stations in the most critical points, and then analysed. Latest data show that, from a chemical and microbiological viewpoint, the river is still in good shape, though Milan's non purified waters, the waters from the Arno stream and the Cerana canal are still an incumbent danger.



Fresh springs

The area between Castano Primo and Besate belongs to the "spring belt". This area is characterised by karst springs of clear and clean water, which springs from the ground, coming from the Alps and filtered through gravel and clay. These springs feed the already rich irriguous system of the Park, and give fertility to the valleys of Morimondo, Casterno di Robecco, Magenta, Cuggiono, Bernate, Boffalora and Abbiategrasso, creating microenvironments with high biological diversity, where freshwater crayfish still live.
